Coach Education : Scholarship Procedure

Scholarships are available to all coaches within the County through funding allocated in the Lincolnshire Athletics Development Plan. This 50% funding can be accessed through Lincolnshire Sports Partnership for level 1 courses, and the modules at level 2, 3 and 4. The funding also covers modules for Fitness & Walking and the Children in Athletics course.

If you are interested in applying for a coach scholarship please contact Julia White on the above details. If you qualify for a scholarship please follow the outlined procedure.

- ❖ A scholarship form will be sent together with a coach education application form by Julia White.
- ❖ Fill in both forms and return the forms with a cheque for 50% of the course fee. Cheques should be made payable to Lincolnshire Sports Partnership and should be sent to Julia White at Lincolnshire Sports Partnership, Unit 9 Allenby Business Village, Crofton Road, Lincoln LN3 4NL.
- ❖ Once received, Julia White will send the booking form together with payment for the course to the UK Athletics administrator to reserve your place.
- ❖ Further details of the course will be sent to you by UK Athletics.

Please note that places cannot be guaranteed until a booking form is received by Julia White and passed onto UK Athletics. Please send forms as quickly as possible to Julia White to ensure your place is paid for and reserved – could you please ensure that Julia is aware that the form has been sent as she works out of the office and will need to travel to receive the form.

Please send payment to Lincolnshire Sport Partnership. Any part payment to the course organiser will not be accepted therefore for all scholarships and booking forms must be sent via Julia White.

Places cannot be funded retrospectively; applicants must apply well in advance of a course to secure their scholarship – minimum of two weeks..

Applicants must be aged over 16 years old for a level one course and over 18 years for any higher course.
